Trinity University held her maiden Matriculation Ceremony and Public Lecture on Saturday, 10th August, 2019 in the University Auditorium at its campus in Yaba, Lagos. The occasion was well attended by prominent individuals from all walks of life. Also present at the Ceremony were eminent personalities from far and near, including the representative of JAMB Registrar, Distinguished Academia from other Institutions viz: University of Lagos, Yaba College of Technology, Mountain Top University and Kola Daisi University, amongst others. Also in attendance were captains of Industries, Men and Women of the Press and invited guests.

he Trinity Vision started about 25 years ago and was born of a deep concern for the alarminglydeclining standards in the quality of education offered by most institutions. The group, like most other Nigerians bemoaned the situation but beyond that, it challenged itself to do something about it, at least, for the sake of 'our own children.' The vision was simply to provide first class education combined with excellent moral and spiritual upbringing. Our response led to the commencement, in October 1995, of Trinity International College, then at No. 10 Adekunle Fajuyi Way, Ikeja GRA, with 8 tiny children, on the first night. In the 24 years during which this College has operated, it has recorded phenomenal at the local achievements and international levels, capped by the fact that, annually, and for many years now, our students have represented Nigeria in the Annual International Science Olympiads.

We proceeded later in 2006 to found Trinity Foundation School, at Ofada, which has simply re-defined the standard of primary education in that axis.

As the challenges both in the education sector as well as in the nation continued, the successes recorded in our two existing institutions motivated the group to advance further into the tertiary sector with the same vision, in order to widen and deepen the scope of our impact Trinity University is therefore not just another University but rather, a university setting out to breed graduates equipped with a certificate that is a statement of excellence in learning, in character, in competence and in contribution to humanity.




